4. What common occurrence in human history does Isa 10:1-4 describe?
5. If God used Assyria to accomplish his purpose, why does He plan to punish them (10:5-7)?
6. What Remnant is spoken of as returning in ch. 10?
7. How was Jesse a stump, and how did a branch shoot up? How will these references to peace be fulfilled? (11:1-9)
8. How will all the nations which ceased to exist (N. Israel, Assyria, Moab, Ammon, Edom, etc.) be gathered again?
9. What new characteristic would be a part of this modern spiritual kingdom? (ch. 12)
